INFORMATION

National Youth Dance Wales (NYDW) was launched in 2000. It provides a national focus for youth dance in Wales and is open to young people, aged between 14 - 21 years, who love dance and dancing!

NYDW works mainly with creative, contemporary dance forms but applications are encouraged from young people with experience of a wide variety of dance styles, including contemporary, ballet, jazz, hip-hop/street dance, modern, etc. as long as participants are willing to transfer their skills to a different way of working – or at least have a go!

NYDW offers first-class training opportunities for young dancers, initially through a programme of open workshops. From these open workshops up to 30 dancers (aged 16 – 21 years) are invited to participate in an intensive dance residency culminating in the public performance of new work – often in some of Wales' most popular theatres (eg. Clwyd Theatr Cymru in Mold, Theatr Brycheiniog in Brecon and Sherman in Cardiff). In 2008, NYDW was invited to perform at The Peacock Theatre in London as part of Youth Dance England's *National Youth Dance Festival*.

Since its first annual residential course in 2001, NYDW has worked with some of Europe's finest, award-winning choreographers - including **Wayne MacGregor** (Random Dance Company) and **Henri Oguike** (Henri Oguike Dance Company). Professional dancers who have worked with NYDW as tutors and mentors currently dance with Random Dance Company, Henri Oguike Dance Company, Richard Alston Dance Company, Diversions - the Dance Company of Wales and Bonachela Dance Company – to mention but a few!

NYDW 2009 Open Workshops

NYDW plans to offer a series of open workshops in locations across Wales - including North, Mid/West, South-west and South-east Wales. Workshop dates and locations will be based on the geographical spread of applications (each workshop must have a minimum of 12 participants; additional dates/locations will be arranged if there is sufficient demand).

NYDW 2009 Annual Residency

Young dancers who wish to be considered for a NYDW residential experience **MUST** have participated in an NYDW Open Workshop; subsequently, dancers will be invited to join the NYDW Residency. Further details will be available at the Open Workshops.

Open Workshops (full day: 10am – 4pm)

Cost: £15 per person

NYDW Open Workshops will include a number of elements: applicants will participate in a technique class (preparing the body through a series of dance exercises), a creative session and a repertory or choreography session (learning a choreographed routine or movement phrases). The workshops will seek to build upon applicants' dance skills and experience, and offer opportunities to explore a range of ideas in a creative way. Further details will be forwarded once workshop places have been confirmed.

Application Requirements

Applicants should be actively involved with a dance group at school/college, or with a local youth dance group or company. They should be aged between 14 – 21 years for the Open Workshops, and between 16 – 21 years if they wish to be considered for the annual NYDW Residency.
